RECYCLE BINS & GARBAGE CANS AT THE CLUBHOUSE

Are for clubhouse use ONLY! Please do not bring your garbage or recyclables to the clubhouse.

YARD WASTE

Yard waste MUST be no longer than 3 feet in length. Any loose material MUST be in a container to be picked up. Do not put it in a plastic garbage bag, use a cardboard box or a garbage can they can pick up and empty. If you have an issue with Yard Waste pick up, call Waste Pro at 595-9390, Spanish Lakes does not pick up.

GARBAGE/TRASH PICK UP

If you have an issue with trash pickup, call Waste-Pro at 595-9390, Spanish Lakes does not pick up. If you have construction debris, it must be no longer than 3 feet long and must be in a barrel or garbage can. Waste Pro will not pick up construction debris if it is laying on the ground.

SLOW DOWN

Please be very careful and watch out for those walking or riding on our streets. Some of our residents ride bikes while some use motorized wheel chairs to get around our community and have had some close calls with cars who have come too close for comfort. Our speed limit is 15 or 20 mph depending where you look, but by no means should anyone be exceeding 20 mph. Safety is our goal for each and every resident here in SLCCV.
